Please consider the following suggested Pledge Amounts:

\$29 - Helps a family with basic necessities, like toiletries, for a whole month

\$50 – Assists an individual with their rental application fees, when transitioning into permanent housing

\$75 - Provides basic cleaning supplies, like laundry detergent, dish detergent, toilet paper and paper towels for a family transitioning into permanent housing

\$100 - Pays monthly program fees for an individual, empowering them to live a life of self-sufficiency during and after they leave the program

\$370 – Provides meals for a resident in Transitional Housing for a month

\$450 – Provides an entire week of *temporary* housing for a homeless family

\$675 - Provides meals for a family for a month

\$1289 – Houses a Family of 4 in Victory Transitional Housing For 30 days
